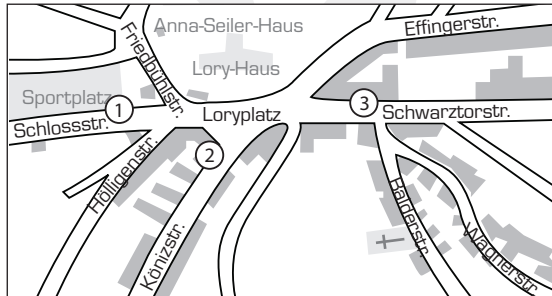

The centre respects the autonomy of undocumented migrants/Sans-Papiers and works unilaterally for their benefit. The centre supports the manifold coping strategies of undocumented migrants/Sans-Papiers and is conscious of the specific realities of women's lives.

The Bernese advisory centre for undocumented migrants/Sans-Papiers advises and passes on information to women and men who live in Switzerland without a residence permit.

Furthermore the centre engages in awareness-raising campaigns for undocumented migrants/Sans-Papiers' in the region of Berne and passes on information about their living conditions to the general public.

The association of the Bernese advisory centre for undocumented migrants/Sans-Papiers is sustained by churches, charities and trade unions. Its work is financed through donations by churches, fondia, the Schellenberg foundation, further foundations and individual contribution.
